

## PERFORMANCE UPLIFTMENT PROGRAM FOR SSC 2019-20 STUDENTS

- An intensive coaching for improvement of SSC – March 2020 Results is proposed to implement in the district from 02.01.2020 to 12.03.2020.
- Revision of syllabus, study classes and daily assessment tests will be conducted for SSC students every day from 8.45 am to 5.45 pm.
- Regular working hours are divided into 6 sessions along with morning assessment class from 8.45 to 10.00 and evening study class from 4.45 to 5.45 pm
- Four cycles of Assessment tests will be conducted from 04.01.2020 on every working day between 8.45 and 10.00 am.
- Successive assessments tests in each cycle are Telugu, Hindi, English, Maths-1, Maths-2, Phy Science, Bio Science and Social (Total 8 assessment tests) as given in the following schedule.
- Assessment test wise syllabus is annexed with this file.
- Assessment test question paper will be prepared for 25 marks in each subject.
- Pattern of Question Paper

Objective type questions	$6 \times \frac{1}{2} = 3$
Very short answer questions	$4 \times 1 = 4$
Short answer questions	$3 \times 2 = 6$
Essay answer questions	$3 \times 4 = 12$
- **Question papers will be prepared by subject senior teachers, typed and mailed to mandal nodal headmasters on previous day (to assessment day) evening, in turn it will be mailed to all the headmasters of ZPP / Govt / Residential / KGBV / APMS / Aided Schools. Headmasters print out the required number of question papers and conduct the assessment test in their schools under their supervision.**
- Headmasters are requested to make their **own arrangements** for printing the question papers.
- Study hours and Revision hours must be handled by subject teachers only, but for conduct of assessment test other teacher must be allotted.
- During the study hours teachers are supposed to be revising the concepts and new pattern of questions to be answered in the SSC Public Examinations March 2020
- After completion of every cycle of tests each subject teacher has to review the students' performance and correct the errors. Headmaster has to submit the school grade sheet to concern Deputy Educational Officer.
- Deputy Educational Officers consolidate the result analysis in their division and submit to the District Educational Officer, for review.
- Pre final exams starts from 27.02.2020 as given by SCERT-AP.
